SYLLABUS & STANDARD FOR TEHSILDAR/NAIB TEHSILDAR COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

1. The standard of the examination shall be the same as prescribed by the Universities in NWFP for Bachelor Degree.
2. A candidate can answer the papers in English or Urdu provided that special instruction will be given on the question paper where it is required to be answered in any one specific Language.
3. The examination shall comprise of the following subjects, carrying maximum marks as noted against each:

S.NO	SUBJECT	MAXIMUM MARKS
i.	General English This paper may include English Essay, precise Writing, Usages of Idioms, etc.	150
ii.	General Urdu This paper may include Urdu Essay, translation from English into Urdu, Prose and Poetry in Urdu etc.	150
iii.	Pakistan Studies As prescribed for Graduate level as compulsory subject.	100
iv.	Islamiyat As prescribed for Graduate level as compulsory subject.	100
v.	General Knowledge and Everyday Science This paper may include questions on world affairs, facts of historical, political, geographical, economic importance and everyday science.	150 (120 marks for General Knowledge and 30 marks for Everyday Science).
vi.	Viva Voce (Oral Test)	200
	Qualifying marks in the aggregate of written papers:	325
	Passing Marks in Viva Voce:	60

4. Non-Muslim candidates will not be required to appear in the paper of Islamiyat. For such candidates the paper of Pak Studies will be of 200 marks instead of 100 marks.
5. No candidate shall be summoned for viva-voce test unless he has obtained at least 33% marks in each individual written paper and 50% marks in the aggregate. A maximum of 5 grace marks may, however, be granted to really deserving candidates in one or two papers, provided that such grant of grace marks shall not entitle the grantee to have a better position in the merit list than those successful candidates who have not been granted any grace marks.
6. No candidate shall be considered to have qualified in the examination unless he has also obtained at least 30% marks in viva-voce test. Failure, in or absence from viva-voce shall mean that the candidate has failed to qualify for appointment and his name will not be included in the merit list.
